

Guidelines for Manuscript Submission Via EDAS (Authors of ICSEDI'26)

ICSEDI'26 uses the EDAS Conference and Journal Management System platform to submit and review all papers. No other means of submission are allowed.

[clicking here will take you to the conference submission page](#) . In order to submit a paper, first you need to **login to EDAS or create an account** if you do not have one yet (Figure-1).

Log in to EDAS account

If you already have an EDAS account. Insert your username and password; if you have forgotten your login details, click on reset your password and follow the on-screen instructions.

Creating EDAS Account

If you do not have an EDAS account, you will need to create one by clicking here:

The process is very similar to registering for any other website with user accounts


Note: Use your university, corporate or government email address than a personal email address, which may delay the creation of the account

On the login screen, click on create a new account, which leads you to the user profile page.

- On the user profile page you need to provide some personal details and agree to EDAS' privacy policy(Figure-2). Please make sure this data is correct, as it is used throughout the whole conference; any typos inserted now will be carried over.

Note: When you submit your information, if there is already an account with a similar name, you may see a list of candidate user names. Check whether your name is already in the list; if yes, use that account. Having multiple EDAS accounts is likely to lead to confusion, such as mis-assigned reviews or papers that are “missing”.


- Once you check the box **This is not a duplicate** and click on **Add this person (Figure-3)**, the system checks whether it can reach your email address and sends you a password link by email.

This ensures that the email address is working and that you can receive emails from EDAS. Usually, the password reset email arrives within a minute or two. Click on Password set link received in your registered email to set your password and [Log in to EDAS account](#)

Selecting the Track

After login, It is very important that you select the most appropriate Track for your paper, as this will impact its reviews. Please read each track description carefully and what kind of papers are accepted. Once you have made your choice, click on the track name to select it (Figure-4)

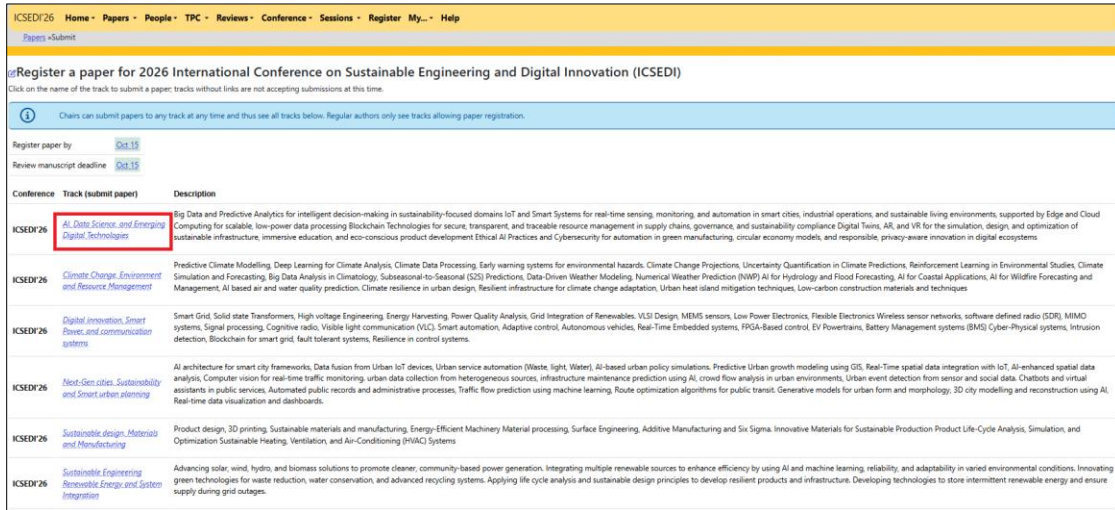


Figure 4: ICSEDI'26 Tracks

In this section you are required to fill in the metadata of your paper for it to be registered in EDAS (Figure-5)

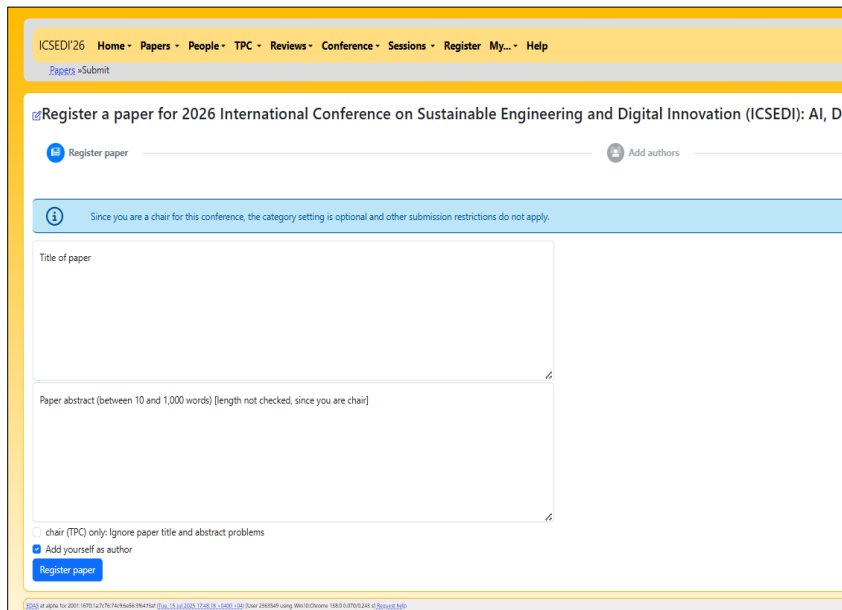


Figure 5: Register a Paper

In this section you are required to fill the Authors of your paper for it to be registered in EDAS(Figure-6)

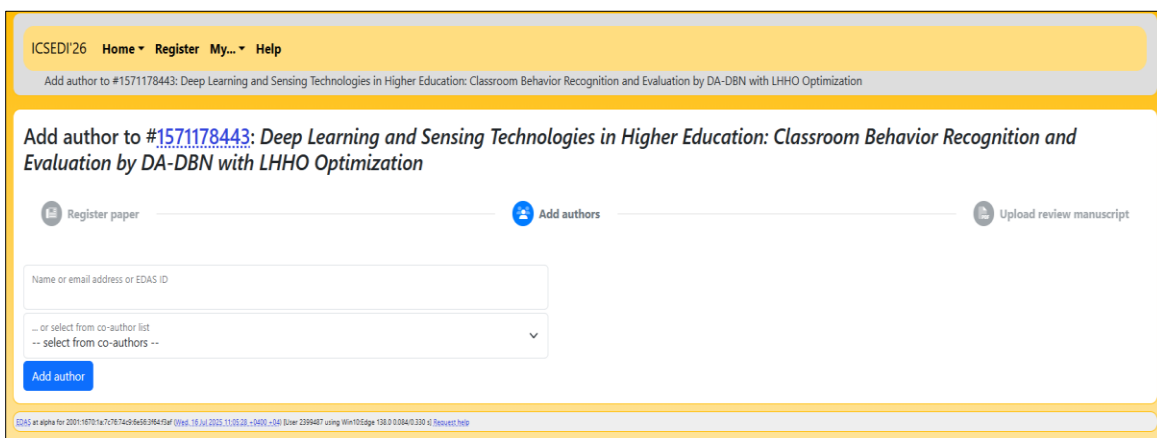


Figure 6: Add Author

Uploading Manuscript

After adding authors , scroll down until you see the option to upload the manuscript(Figure-7)

Select the PDF file from your computer and click on Upload PDF(Figure-8).EDAS will automatically check a few things on the document,including size (A4)and 7 pages for a full paper).If you have not changed the paper template nor gone past the page limit, the upload should be successful and EDAS will display the message.

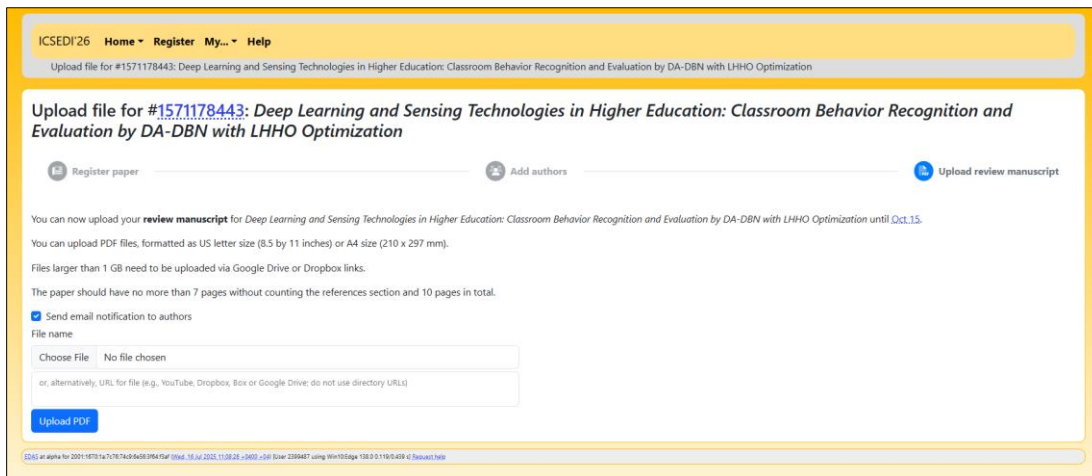


Figure 8: Upload PDF

Paper status has changed to Active (has manuscript) (Figure-9) If there are errors with your paper, please fix them before resubmitting it ([Refer instructions page](#)). You will receive an automatic email from EDAS after performing this step.

Note: You can upload an updated version of the paper at any time up to the submission deadline by clicking on the cloud icon next to Paper for review . Do not register a new paper in EDAS if you just need to update the PDF file. This can lead to desk-rejection.

Instructions to upload manuscript as PDF

- Manuscript Template: The conference language is English. Prospective authors must submit original papers with 4-6(four to six) pages. Papers must be written using the IEEE conference proceedings style format (two-column and 10-point font). For more information on IEEE style formats, see: <https://www.ieee.org/conferences/publishing/templates>
- Similarity rating: Your manuscript's similarity rating must be less than 20%. Submissions with a 20% or above similarity rating will be dropped and no longer considered for ICSEDI'26.
- Artificial Intelligence (AI) use: AI tools should not be used to generate texts or content directly. AI tools can be permitted to improve grammar and language, and the use must be disclosed in the acknowledgment section.
- Paper checklist: Please ensure your paper complies with the following checklist to pass quality control for inclusion in IEEE Xplore. When your manuscript is accepted with a revision, please check the revision using the checklist and later save the checklist file for uploading during the registration process, as follows:
 1. Title and abstract are FREE of symbols, special characters, footnotes, or math.
 2. The authors' names in the list DO NOT contain any numbers.
 3. The whole paper, including figures and tables, is in English.
 4. Use reference software such as Mendeley, EndNote, etc., and use the IEEE reference style. While English references are preferred, non-English references (such as references in Bahasa Indonesia) should constitute no more than 20% of the total references. Ensure it includes the page numbers and month of publication of journal and conference articles, the issue number of journal articles, and/or the DOI.
 5. All figures are precise, including any text inside the figure. Place figures and tables at the top and bottom of columns. Avoid placing them in the middle of columns. Prominent figures and tables may span across both columns.
 6. All figures, graphics, and tables should be High-resolution.
